The Challenge

Lack of proper nutrition slows down their learning and understanding which hampers their mental growth. Their learning level is low they are not enrolled in their respective class according to their age. Irregularity & School timing is also a big challenge.

Overview

The KHEL Model (Knowledge Hub for Education and Learning) envisages establishing open learning spaces for socially and economically disadvantaged children and youth. KHEL does not limit itself to helping the child acquire basic literacy but focuses on holistic learning so that the child grows intellectually and not just mechanically as often happens in the context of schools/institutions serving the underprivileged.

Community Mobilization

Community visits, interacting with the parents and mobilizing them to send the children to the centre regularly. Parent Teacher meetings- Parent Teacher meetings were organized almost on all Sundays at the door step of the children. A few visit the center when called.
